



## PetSet to Host Large-Scale Animal Transport at William P. Hobby Airport, Advancing Efforts to Reduce Pressure on Local Shelters

**HOUSTON, TX:** PetSet will host a coordinated animal transport with [Wings of Rescue](#) on May 14 at William P. Hobby Airport, bringing together local shelters, partners, and volunteers to relocate 160 animals from across the city to receiving shelters in Minnesota.

The transport aims to move adoptable animals out of overcrowded local facilities and off the streets, helping create safer, healthier communities for both pets and people. By connecting Houston-area animals with shelters that have greater adoption capacity, the effort supports long-term solutions to animal homelessness.

This effort comes at a critical time as Houston prepares to welcome visitors from around the world for the FIFA World Cup 2026, underscoring the importance of proactive, community-driven solutions that enhance public safety and quality of life across the city.

“This transport represents what’s possible when communities come together around proactive solutions,” said Tama Lundquist. “Every animal we move is one less animal at risk on our streets and one more opportunity for a safe, permanent home.”

Animals participating in the transport will come from multiple locations across the Houston area, including Wolly Kitten Club who is sending more than 100 cats, reflecting the scale of need and the strength of regional collaboration. Upon arrival in Minnesota, the animals will be placed with two partner shelters: Angel of Hope and the Babinski Foundation, to facilitate rapid adoption.
